- ➡ Global Sisterhood: Delegates from across Africa and the diaspora shared grassroots success stories, strengthening cross-border solidarity.

2025 – Dakar, Senegal

Theme: "Accelerate Action: A Call to Ignite, Empower, and Engage African Women for Transformative Realities"

- Attendance: Notable delegates from across Africa and the diaspora, including Her Excellency the First Lady of Kebbi State (Nigeria) and the President of the Defence and Police Officers' Wives Association.

- ➡ Green Leadership: A tree-planting initiative in Diamniadio, covered by Senegalese media, highlighted women's pivotal role in climate action.
- ➡ Healing Through History: Visits to Gorée Island and the African Renaissance Monument ignited poignant discussions on identity and collective healing.

- ➡ Celebrating Excellence: Awards honoured more than 10 change-makers, such as trailblazing bankers and tourism advocates, amplifying their influence.
